We are recruiting a **Social Worker- Part time (2 to 3 days per week)**

#### **Key Areas of Responsibility and Duties include:**

- Performing comprehensive psycho-social, therapeutic and risk assessments, in accordance with evidence based clinical guidelines with clients across the lifespan;
- Identifying and prioritizing client psycho-social needs from a population health perspective;
- Providing a spectrum of care that ranges from early prevention to offering time limited counselling services (1:1 and group sessions);
- Facilitating interventions that typically focus on self-esteem, mental health, dysfunctional communication patterns, and maladaptive coping strategies;
- Documenting encounter data and client care activity concisely and accurately;
- Collaborating with inter-professional team members to develop customized care plans based on best practices;
- Advocating and facilitating referrals to community resources and supportive services;
- Participation in program and service development.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Member of the Ontario College of Social Workers & Social Service Workers;
- Baccalaureate or Masters degree of Social Work from an accredited School of Social Work;
- 3-5 years recent SW experience preferably within a community based or out-patient setting;
- Excellent short term counselling, crisis intervention and group facilitation skills with competency in the areas of depression, trauma and substance abuse;
- Competency in the application and interpretation of cognitive and mental health screening tools;
- Proficiency with Electronic Medical Records (EMR) and computer knowledge required;
- Excellent knowledge of community resources to foster referrals and service linkage;
- Demonstrated knowledge in the principals of health promotion, the social determinants of health and client advocacy;
- English proficiency is required and a proficiency in French is an asset.
